



SEED & SUPPLIES FOR NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

NATIVE GRASS PLANTING & MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

- 1. Mow** project start of summer for fire control
& mow summer growth before fall rains.
- 2. Spray** contact herbicide for weeds and annual grasses
immediately after mowing.
- 3. Spray** second application of contact herbicide mid-winter or
when the second crop of weeds is approx. two inches tall.
- 4. Hydroseed** late winter before rains subside. No tilling prior to
hydroseeding, no fertilizing. Live annual grasses and
weeds should not be present prior to hydroseeding.
- 5. Mow** early spring, weather permitting, for any annual grasses
or weeds which have emerged since hydroseeding.
- 6. Pre-emergent** in mid-spring for late germinating annual grasses
and weeds. Only apply pre-emergent when hydroseeded
grasses have germinated and have become established
enough to withstand a pre-emergent (approx. eight weeks).
- 7. Fertilize** mid-spring with ammonium sulfate *only* if hydroseeded native
grasses are beginning to show dominance on the site.

OR

- 8. Mow** late spring then "spot" spray broadleaf herbicide on annual
grasses and weeds.
